

# Rubber Band Dyed Eggs



## Supplies

Hard-boiled Eggs

Rubber Bands (try a variety of widths!)

Cups with Hot Water (1 cup for every color of food coloring)

White Vinegar

Favorite Colors of Food Coloring

Cooking Oil or Olive Oil

Spoons

## Directions

In each cup, add a tablespoon of vinegar, food dye (one color of dye per cup), and 1 teaspoon of oil. Make sure your cup is filled high enough to cover the entire egg. Stir the mixture and drop an egg into cup (The first color should be a light soft color). Pat dry and place some rubber bands around your egg. Then, dip into another color slightly darker than the first color. After you remove your rubber bands, you can stop there with just two colors. If you want to keep going, dip your egg in again and repeat the same process. When you are done, remove all rubber bands.
